Residents expressed their concerns as they have business's that are being affected by the extra footfall on and around their land. Tractors need to be able to move up and down the lane without fear of accidents.

Dog fouling being left or dumped on and around the bridleway and adjacent land. Dogs being allowed off leads, causing nuisance and raising safety concerns for livestock, pets, and walkers.

Complaints were discussed concerning late-night noise from the wedding venue. Noise being too loud for residents to sit in their own garden comfortably.

The issue of Annabels using their own land was discussed as this would make the situation much better with a road/track straight to the café.

Jackie (Ward Councillor) reported CDC are due to meeting next Thursday 29<sup>th</sup> and this would be discussed with the relevant departments. After this they will come back to the Parish Council with how to move forward and arrange a meeting for everyone involved, before arranging a public meeting.
